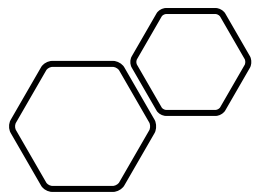
We've played 92 games through May 7, 2026

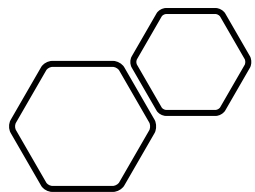
