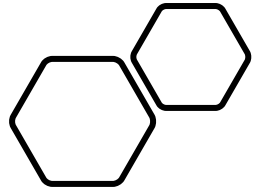

- Sponsor - CEDC (Covington Economic Development Corporation) / Covington Main Street

- Date - February 7, 2026 (inclement weather date February 14)

- Setup Time - 7:30 am - 10:00 am

- Event Time - 10:00 am - 4:00 pm

- Cleanup Time - 4:30 pm

- Details - Annual Chocolate Tour with approximately 20 stops at square retail stores and 3 locations at the depot to receive chocolates with purchase of ticket

- They will sell approximately 2,000 tickets

- There will be no additional vendors - only storefronts around the square

- There will be one group set up in Court Square Park (BGCHRR)

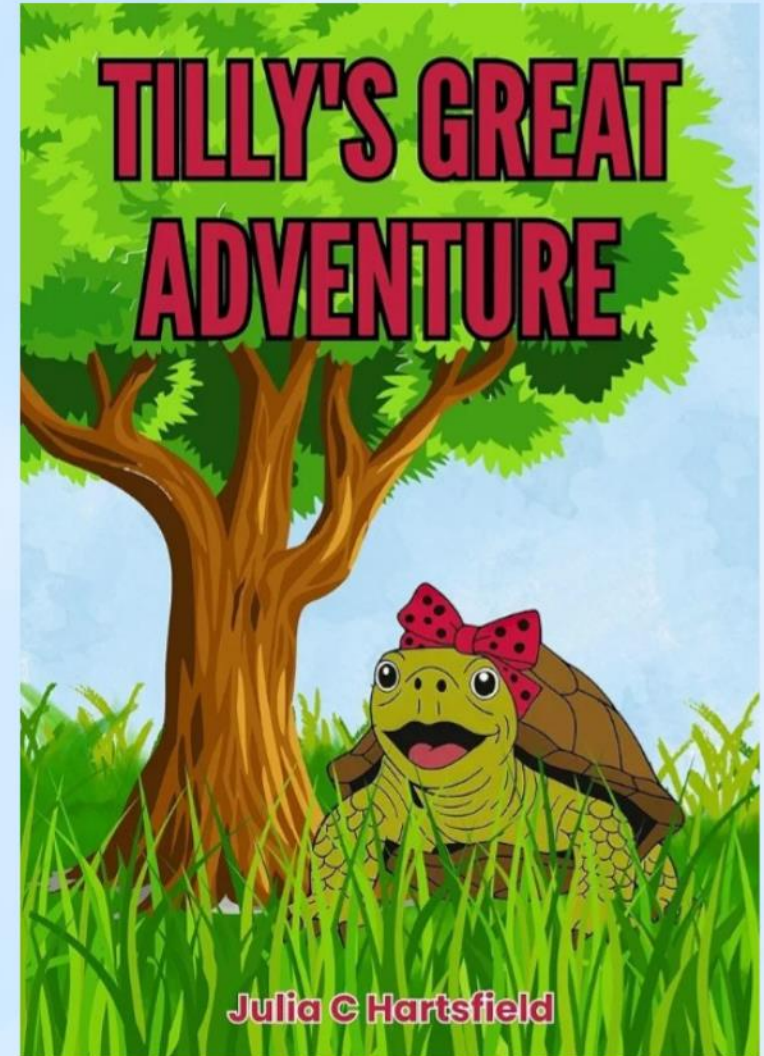
