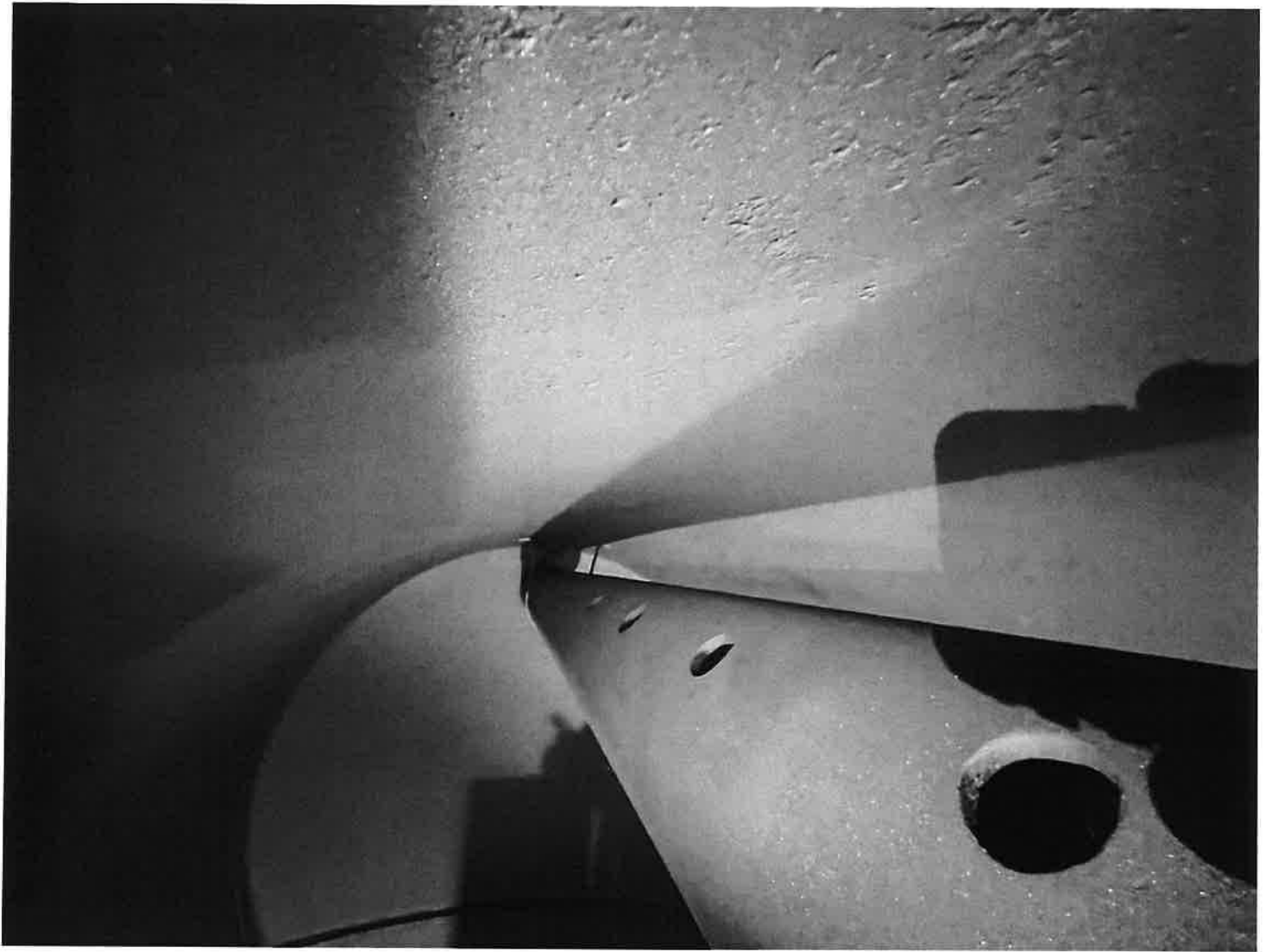

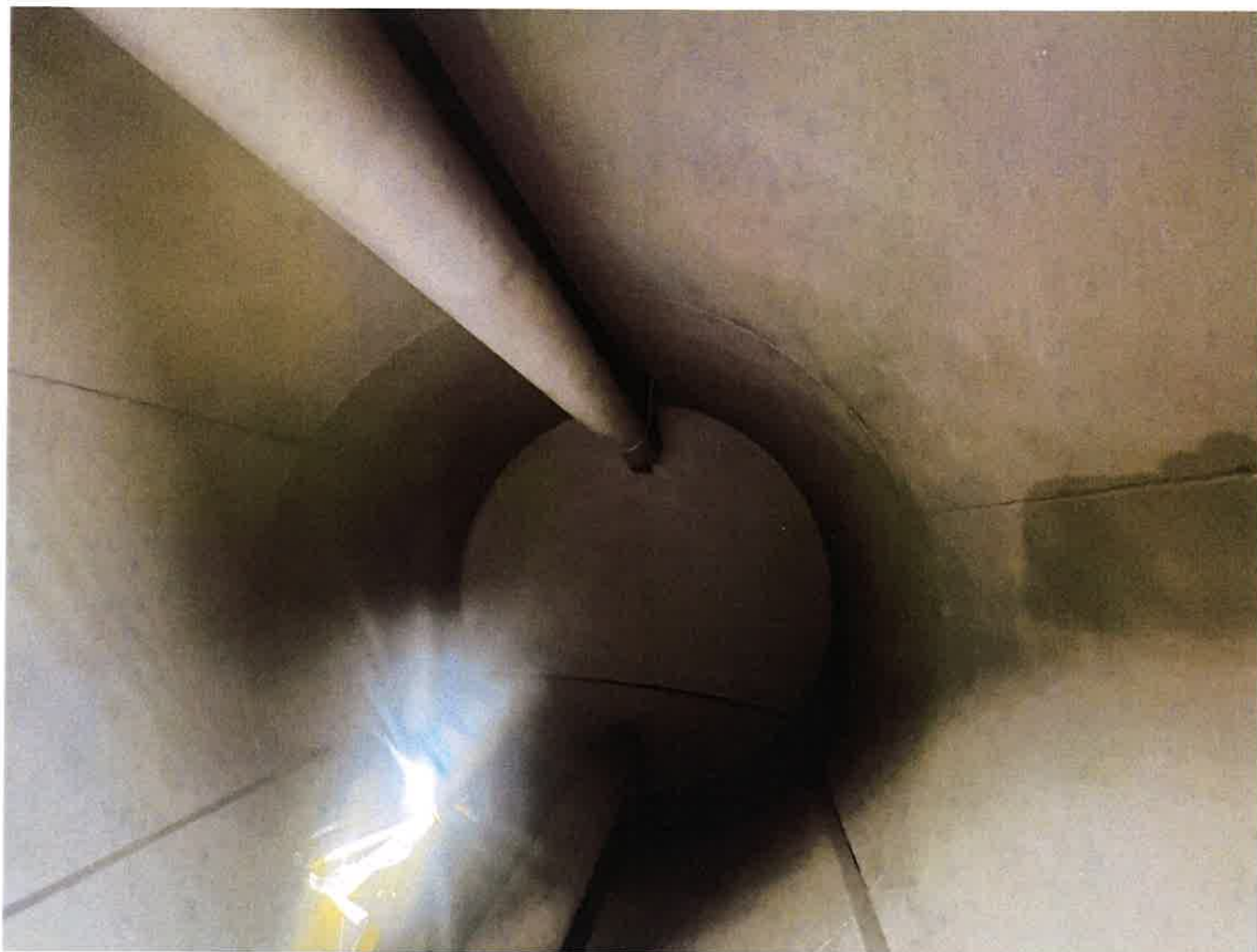

The Tennessee Department of Transportation (TDOT) is pleased to inform you that your Transportation Planning Grant (TPG) application for the **Community Transportation Asset Inventory Plan** (formerly Resurfacing Plan) has been approved for funding.
